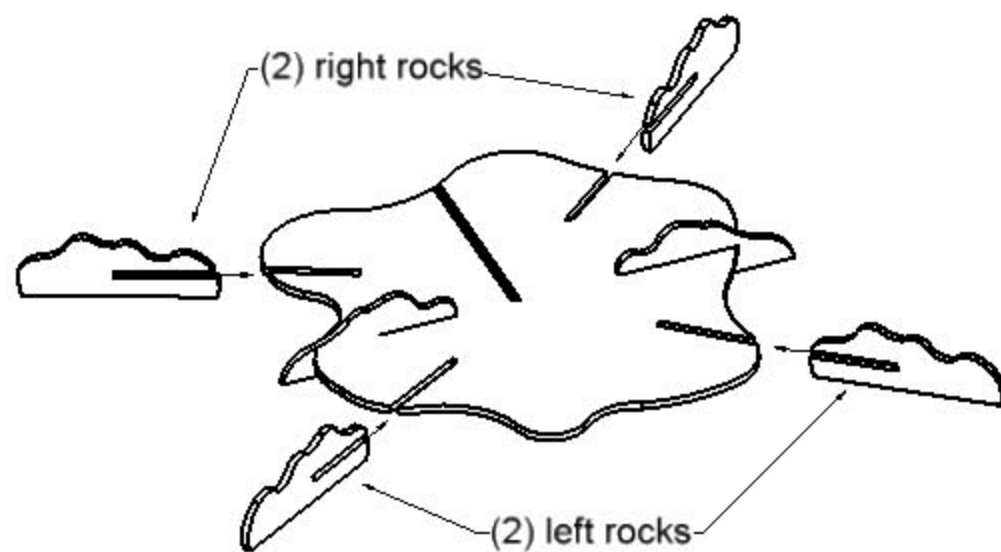
Attach the 2 middle rocks to the base.

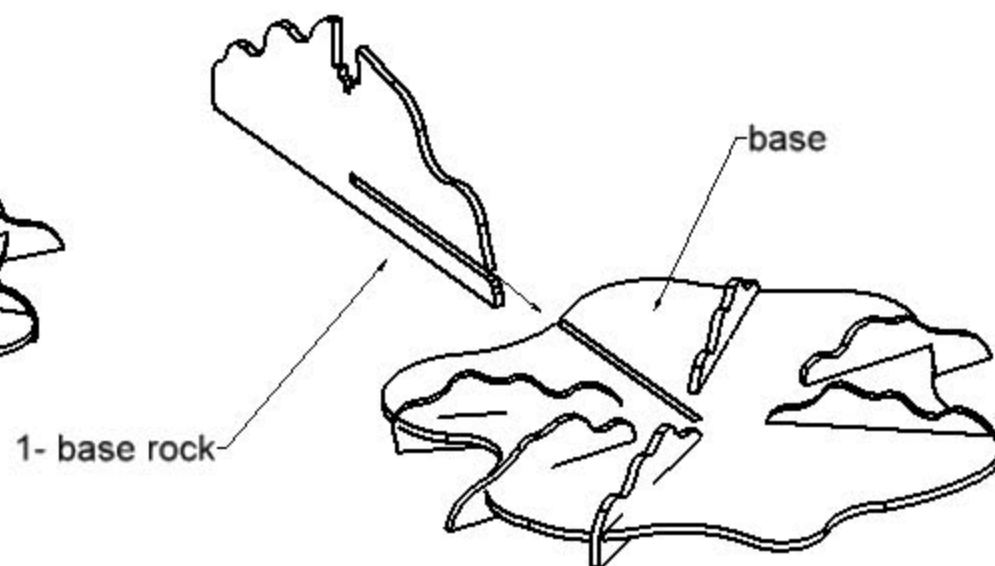

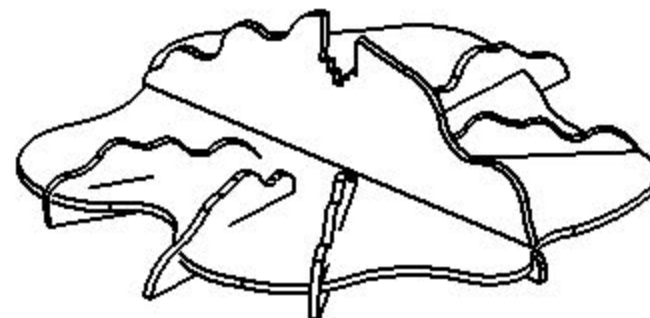

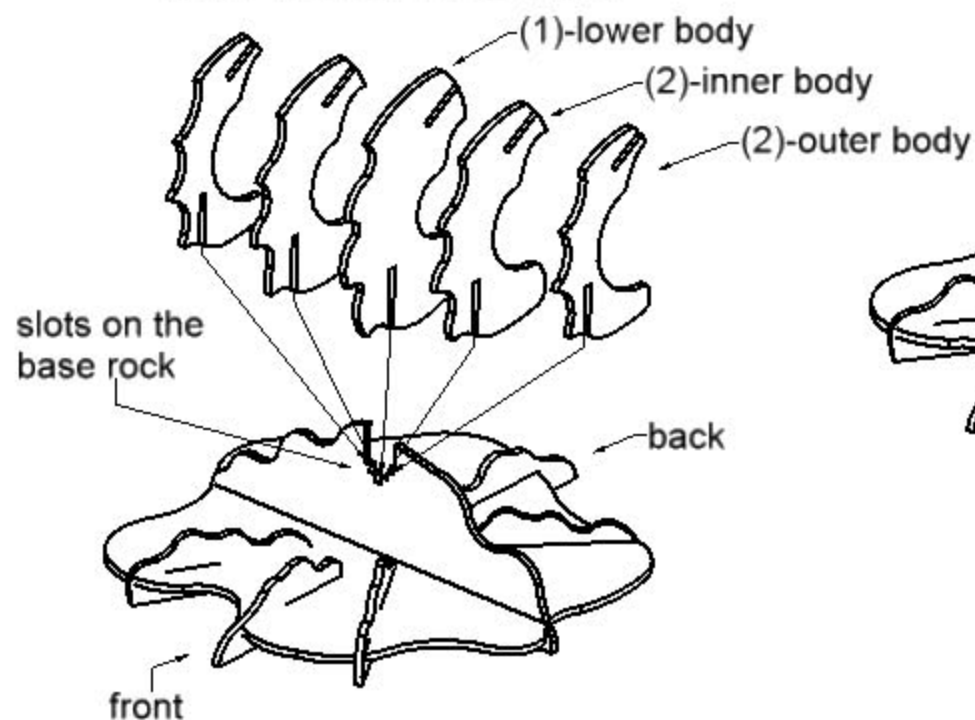
Attach the (base rock), to the base.



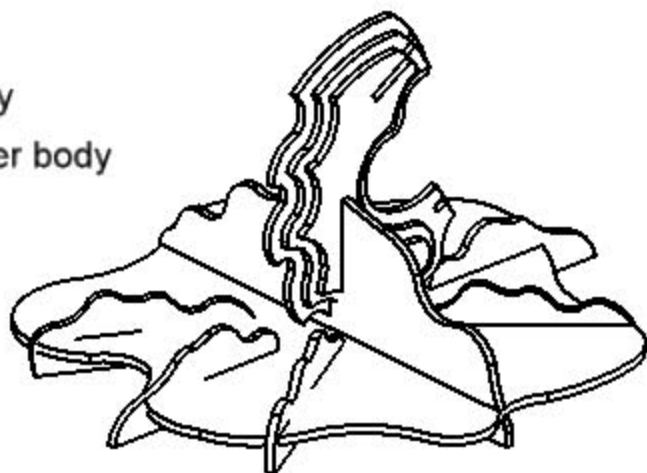

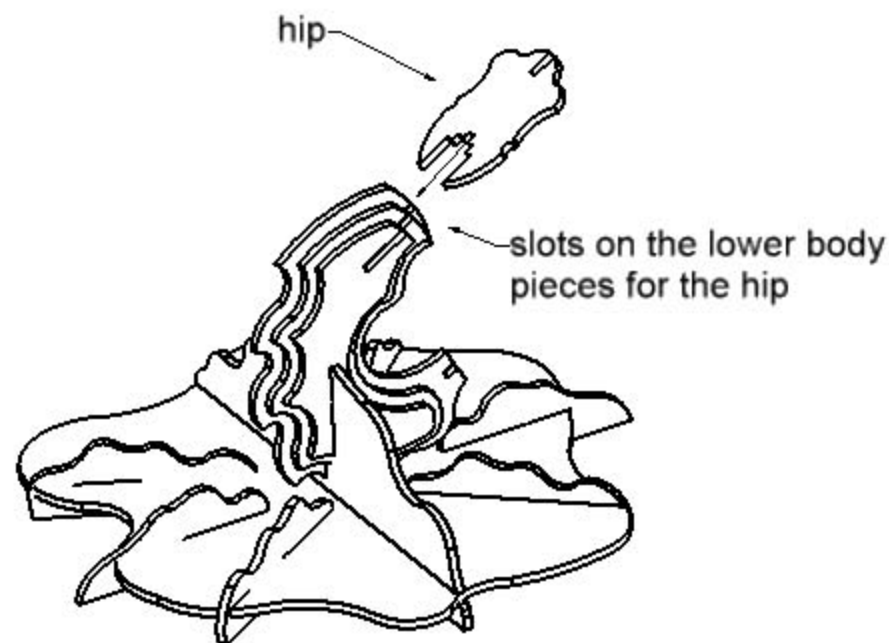

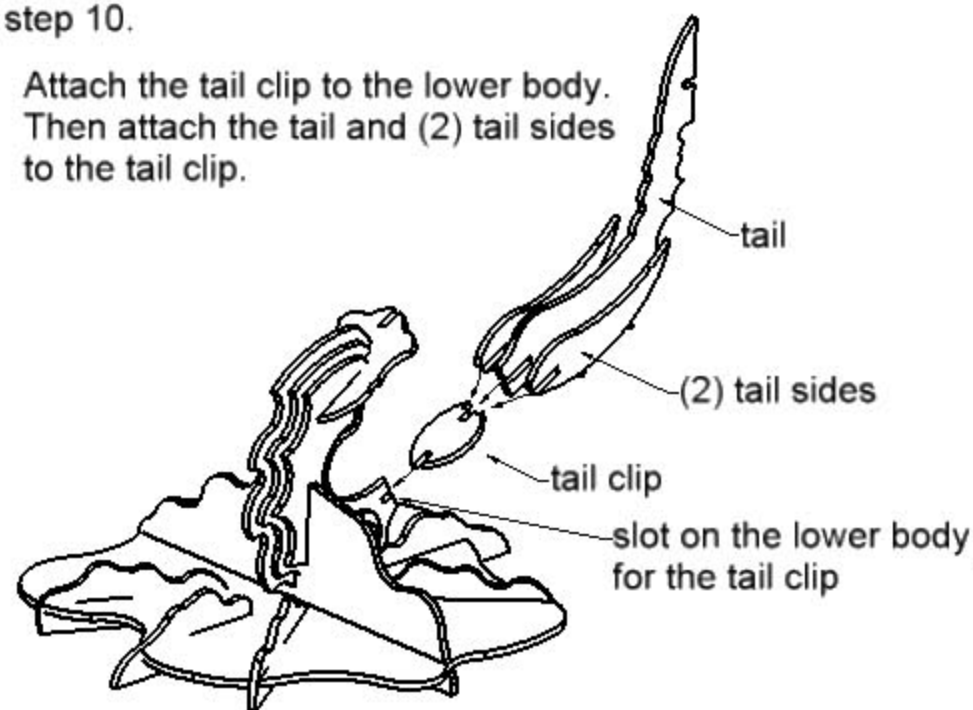

Attach the hip to the slots on the lower body pieces.

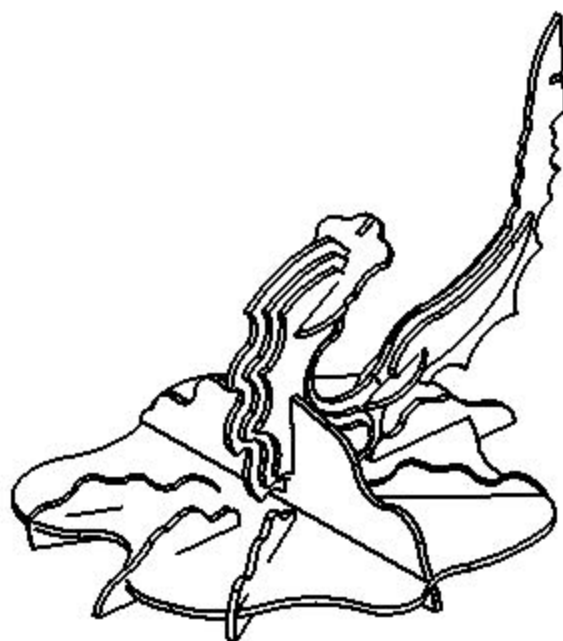


step 10.

Attach the tail clip to the lower body. Then attach the tail and (2) tail sides to the tail clip.

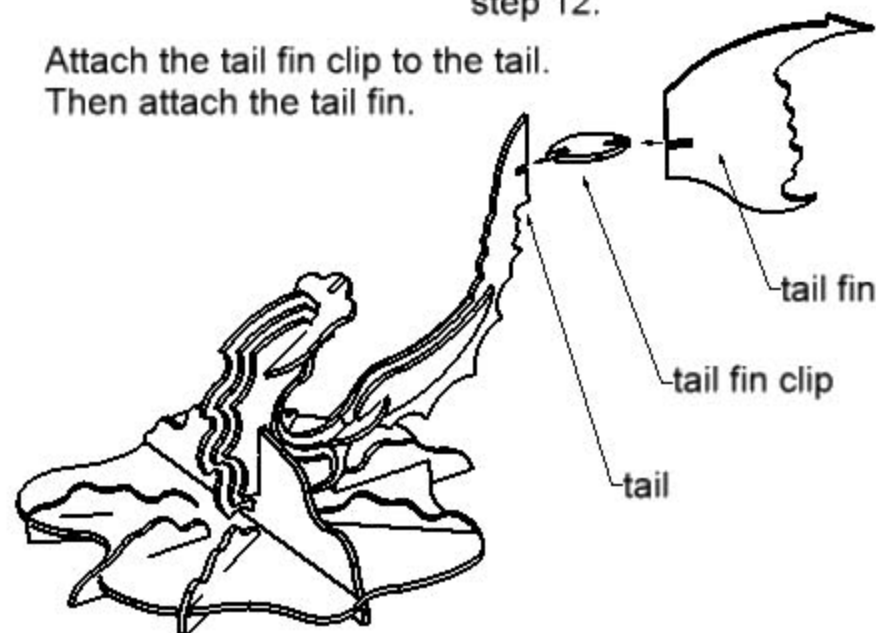

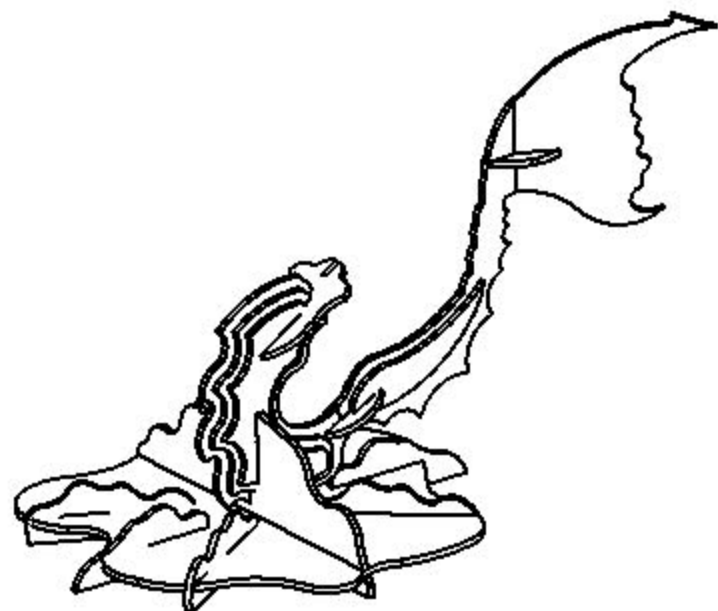

Attach the tail fin clip to the tail. Then attach the tail fin.

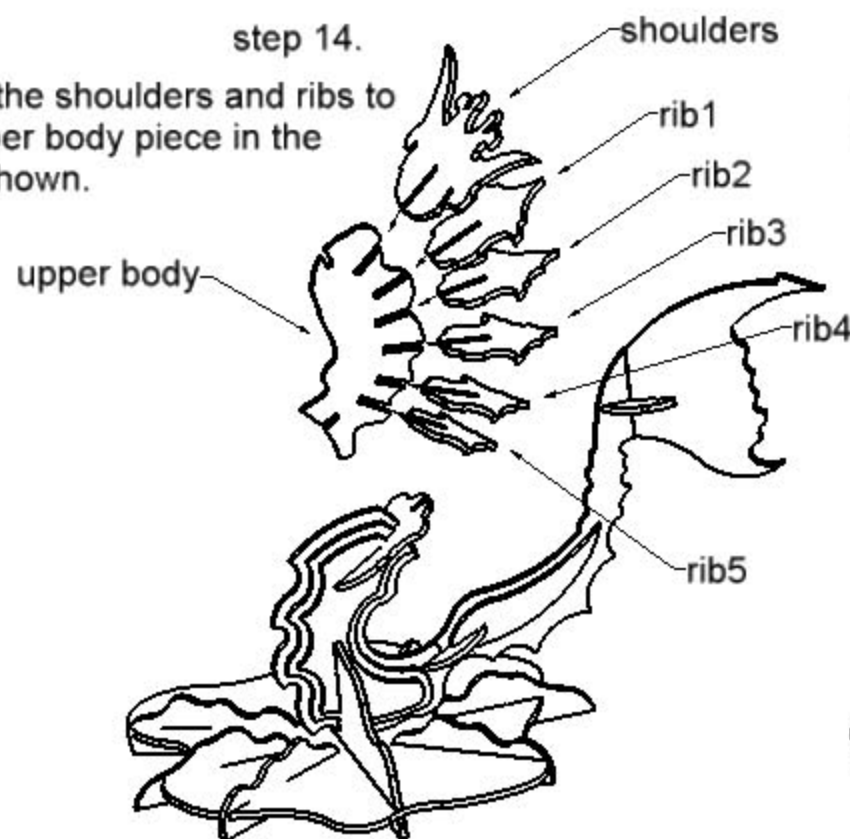

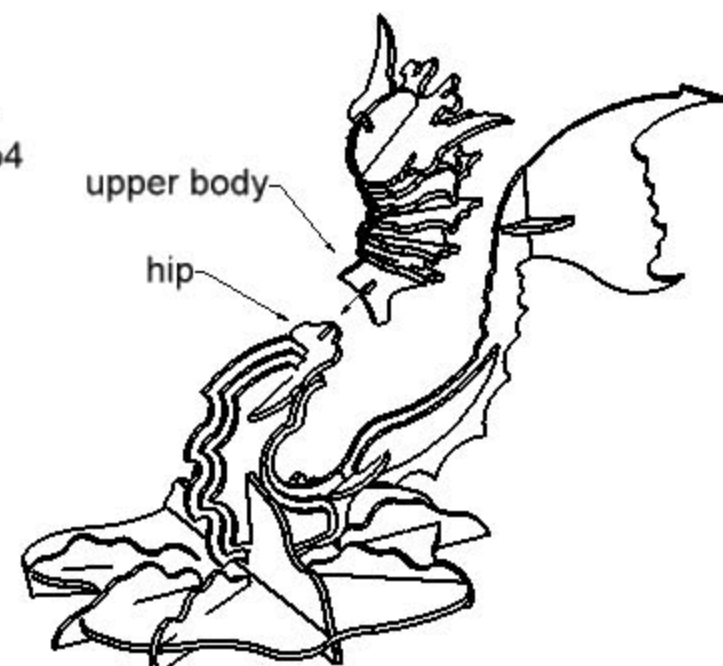

Attach the shoulders and ribs to the upper body piece in the order shown.

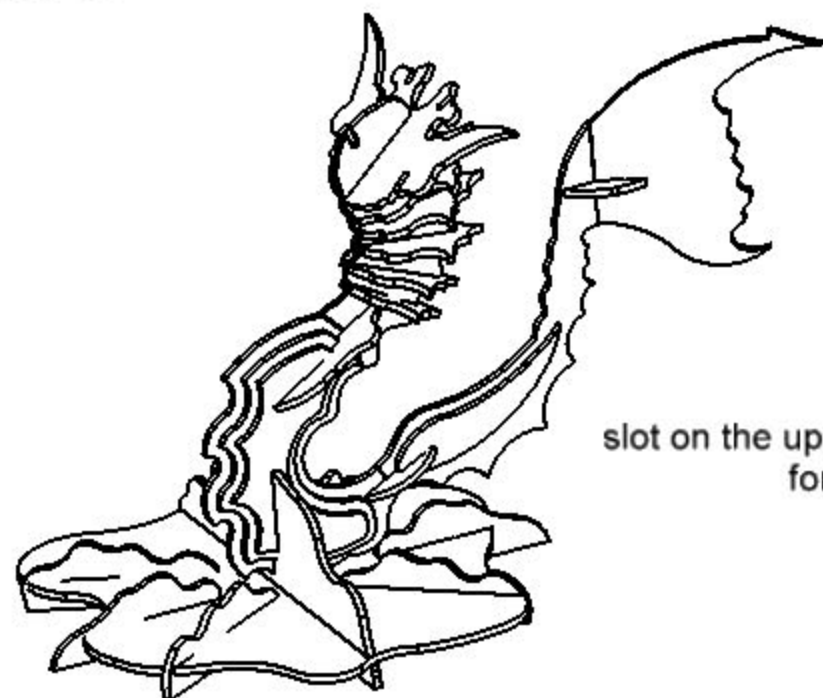

Attach the upper body, (with the ribs on it) to the slot on the top of the hip.

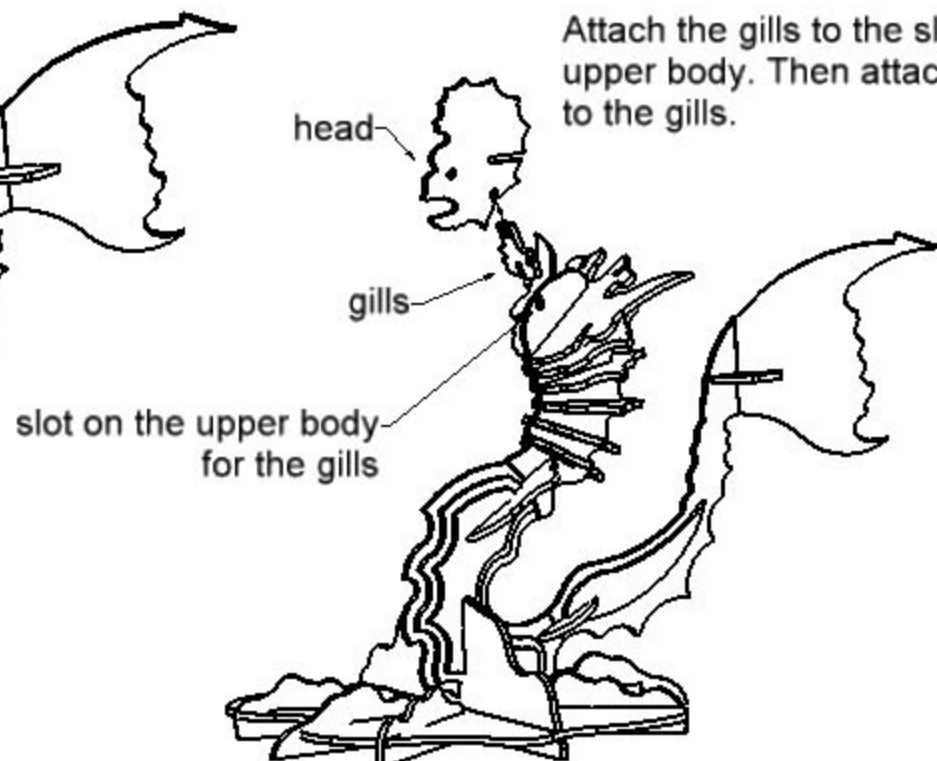

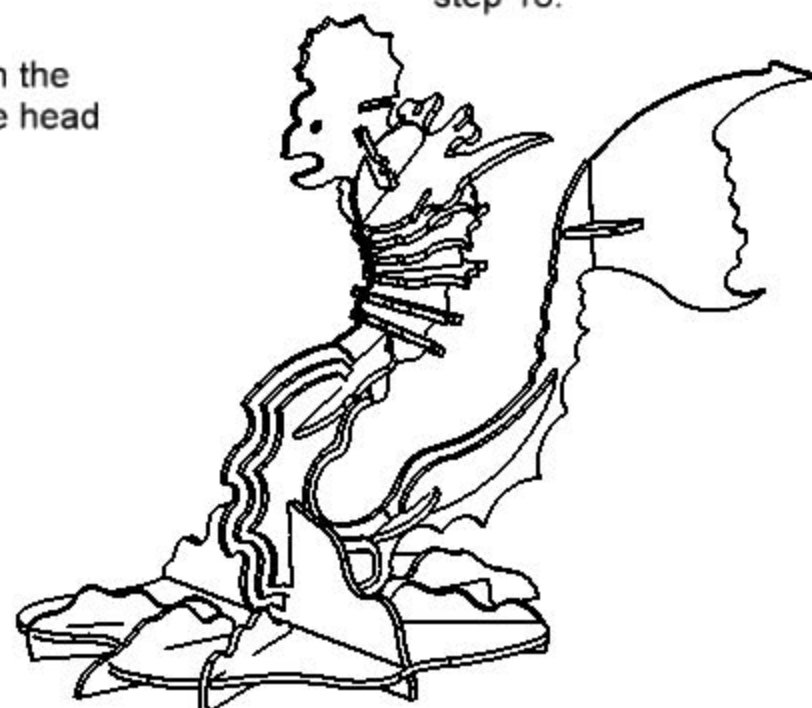

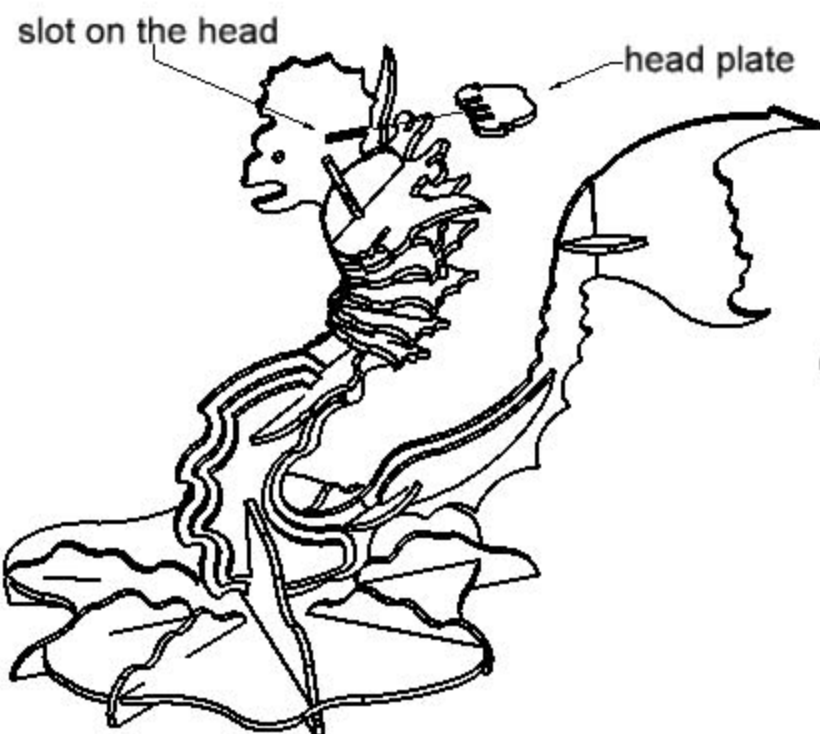
Attach the gills to the slot on the upper body. Then attach the head to the gills.

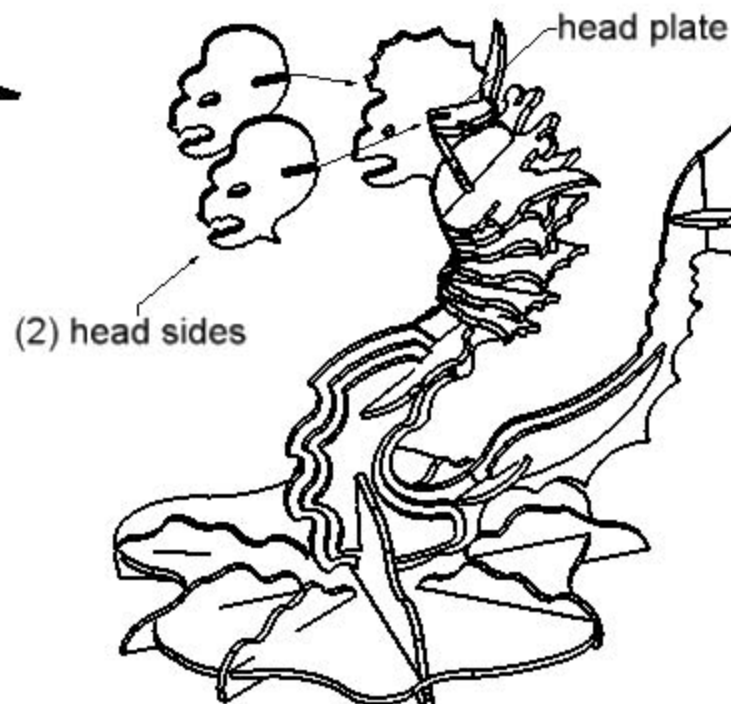


step 19. Attach the center slot on the head plate to the slot on the head.

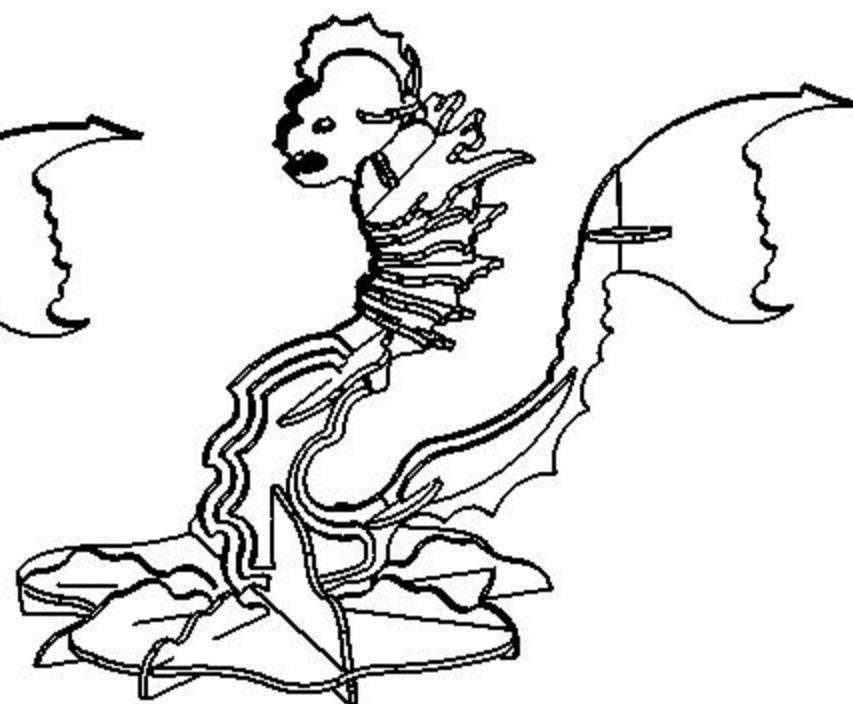

Attach the (2) head sides to the slots on the head plate.

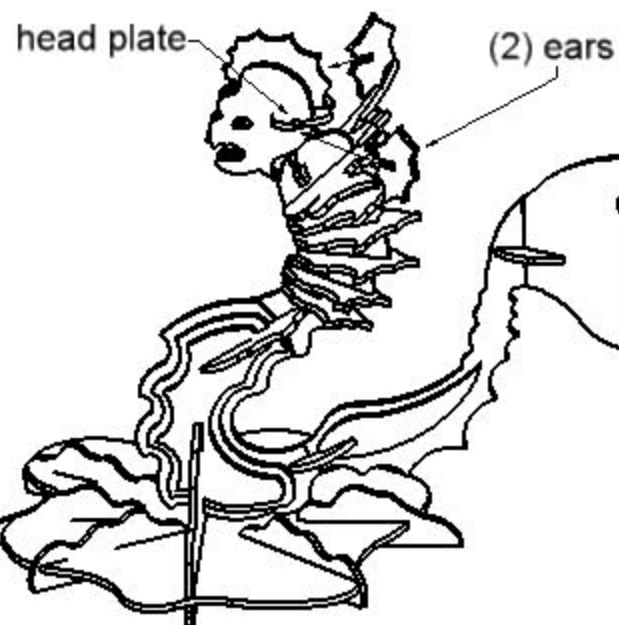

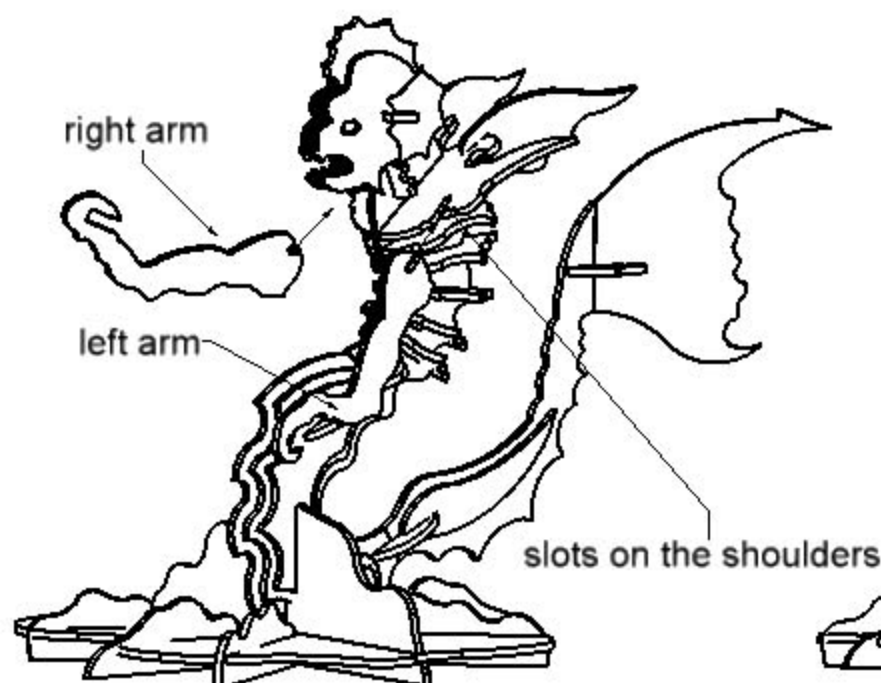

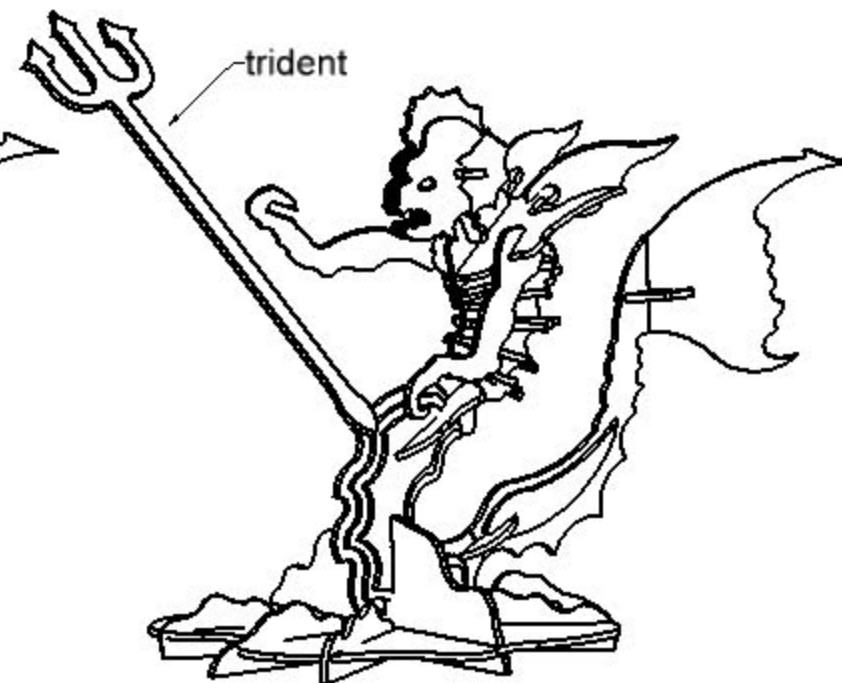
step 25. Attach the left and right arms to the slots on the front of the shoulders.
