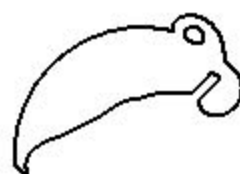

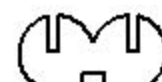

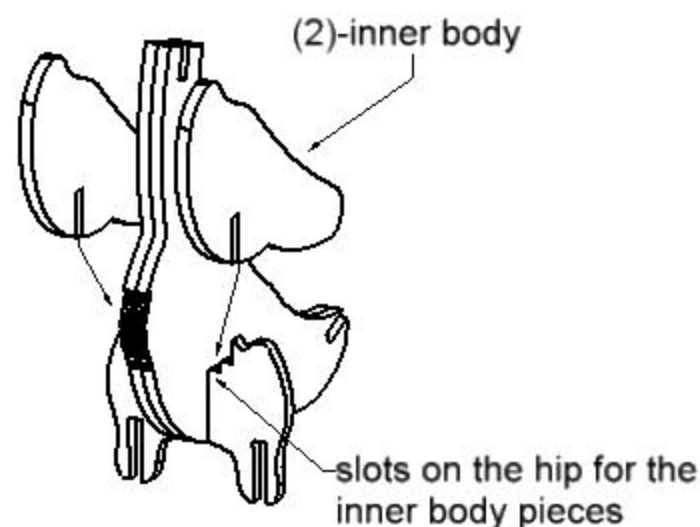
step 1.

Attach the bottoms of the (2) road runner body pieces to the double wide slot in the center of the hip.



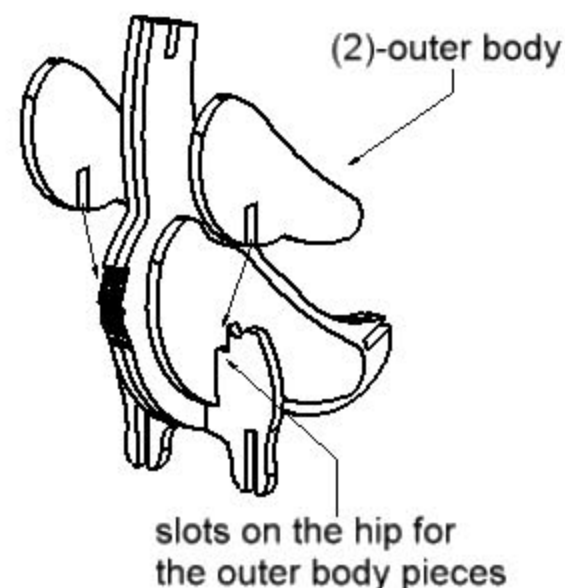
step 2.

Attach the (2) inner body pieces to the lower slots on the hip.



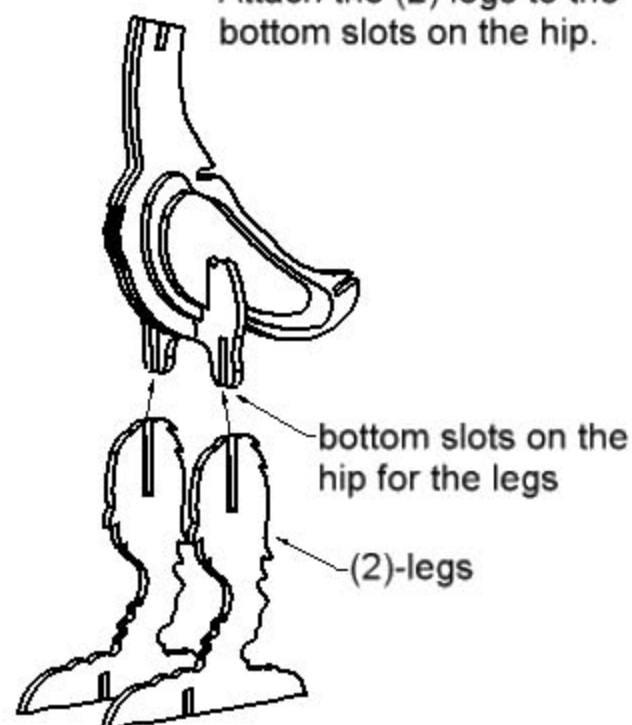
step 3.

Attach the (2) outer body pieces to the last slots on the hip.



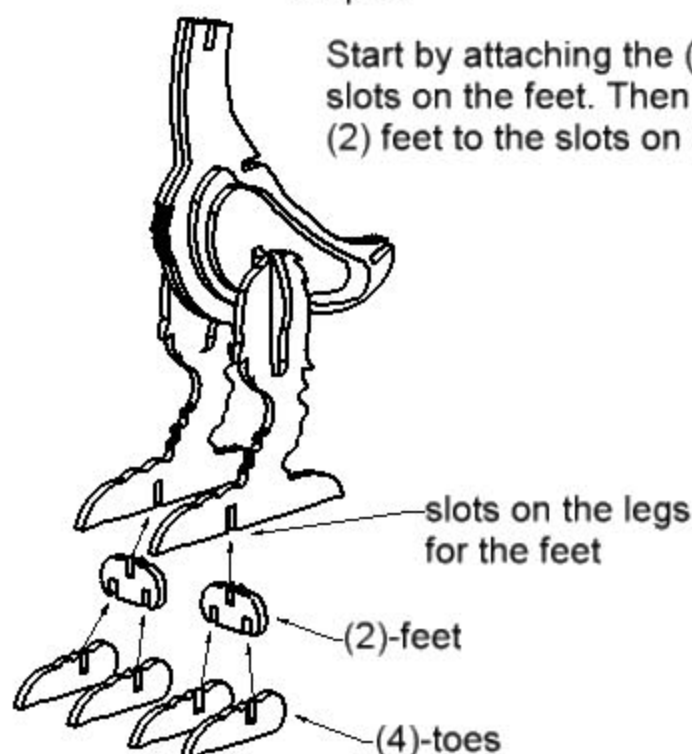
step 4.

Attach the (2) legs to the bottom slots on the hip.



step 5.

Start by attaching the (4) toes to the slots on the feet. Then attach the (2) feet to the slots on the legs.

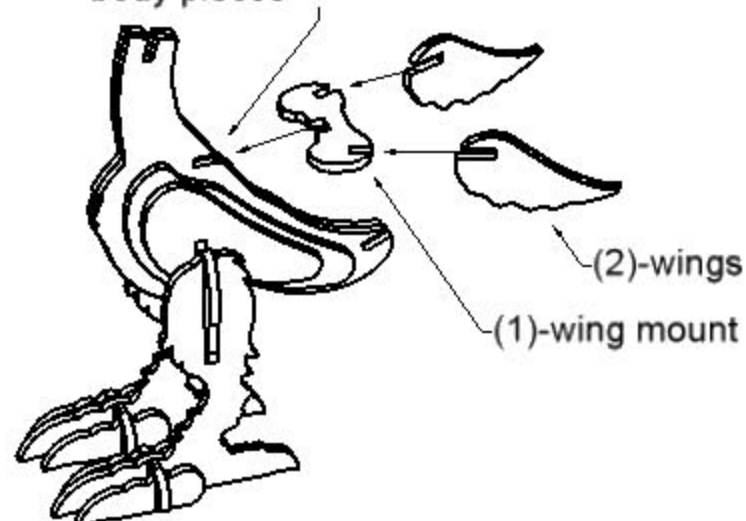


step 6.

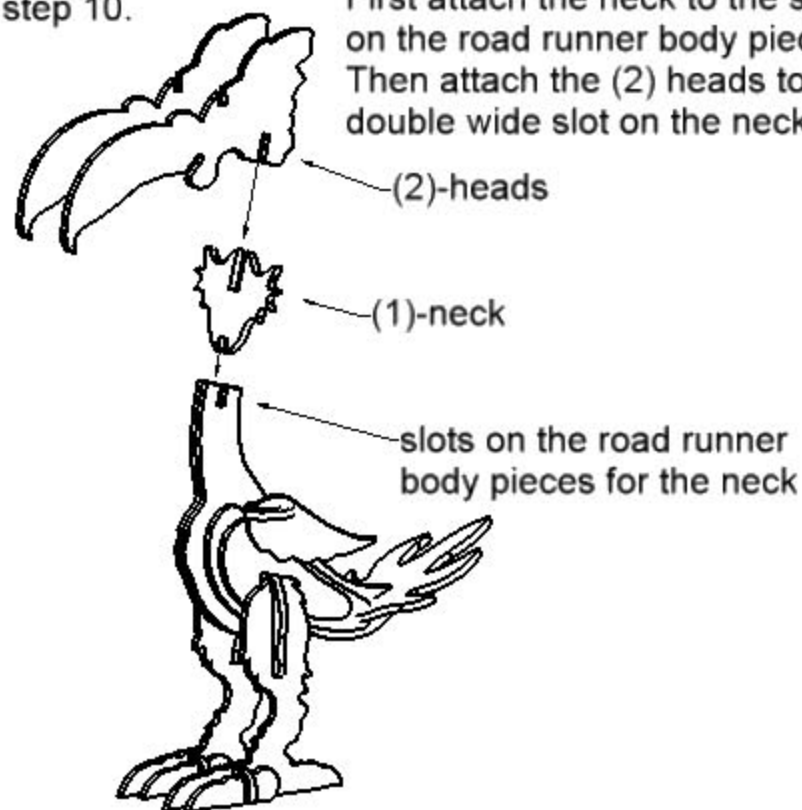


- step 7. Attach the wing mount to the slots on the back of the road runner body pieces. Then attach the (2) wings to the angled slots on the wing mount.

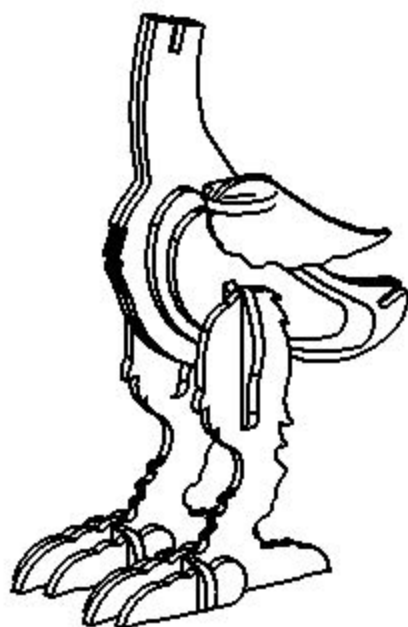
slots on the (2) road runner body pieces



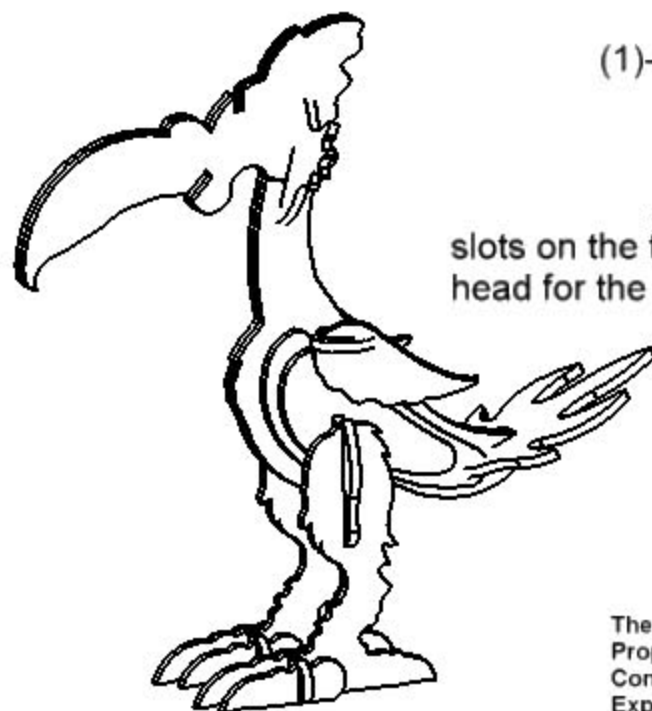
- step 10. First attach the neck to the slots on the road runner body pieces. Then attach the (2) heads to the double wide slot on the neck.

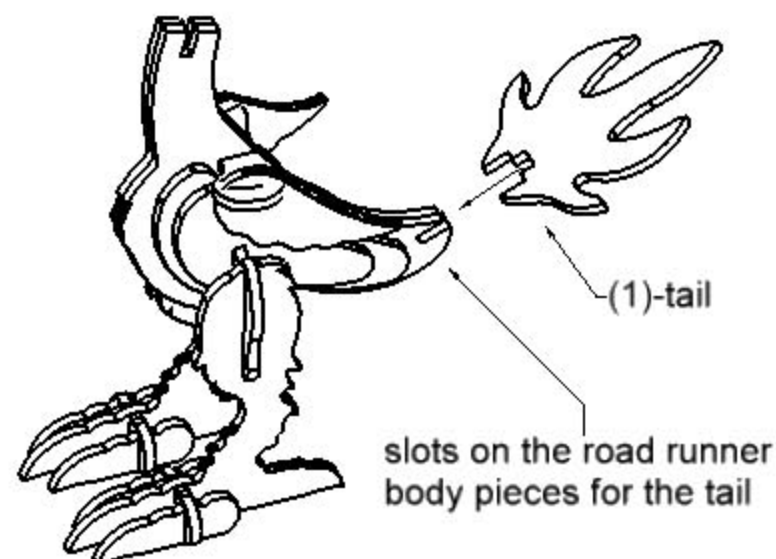

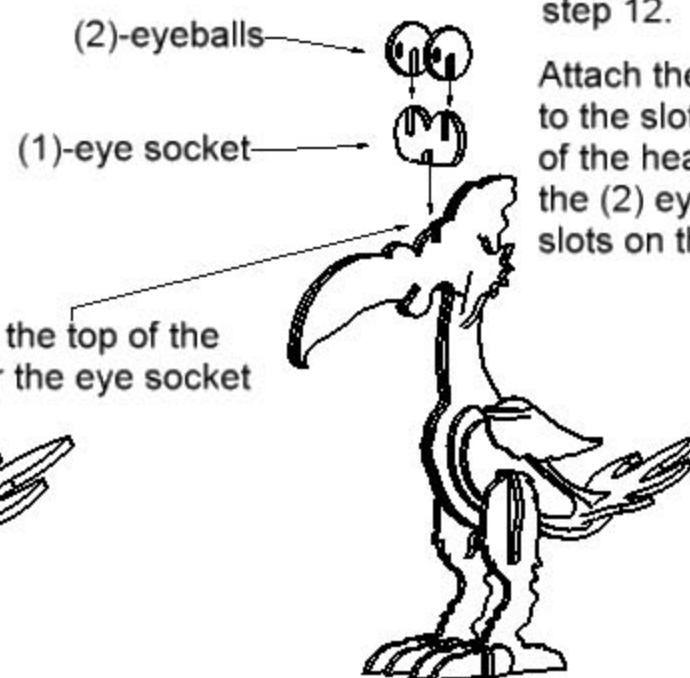

- Attach the tail to the slots on the rear end of the road runner body pieces.

- Attach the eye socket to the slots on the top of the head. Then attach the (2) eyeballs to the slots on the eye socket.

Completed "toons" Road Runner 3d puzzle.



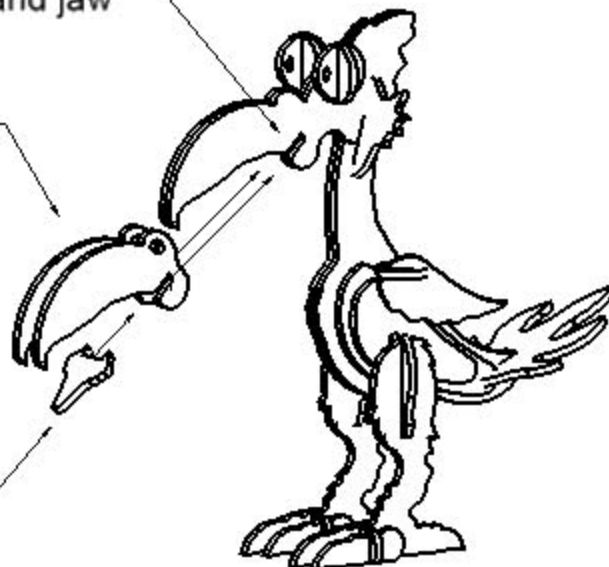
step 14.

First use one hand to line up the (2) beaks with the slots on the head pieces. Then slide the jaw on the (2) beaks and head pieces.

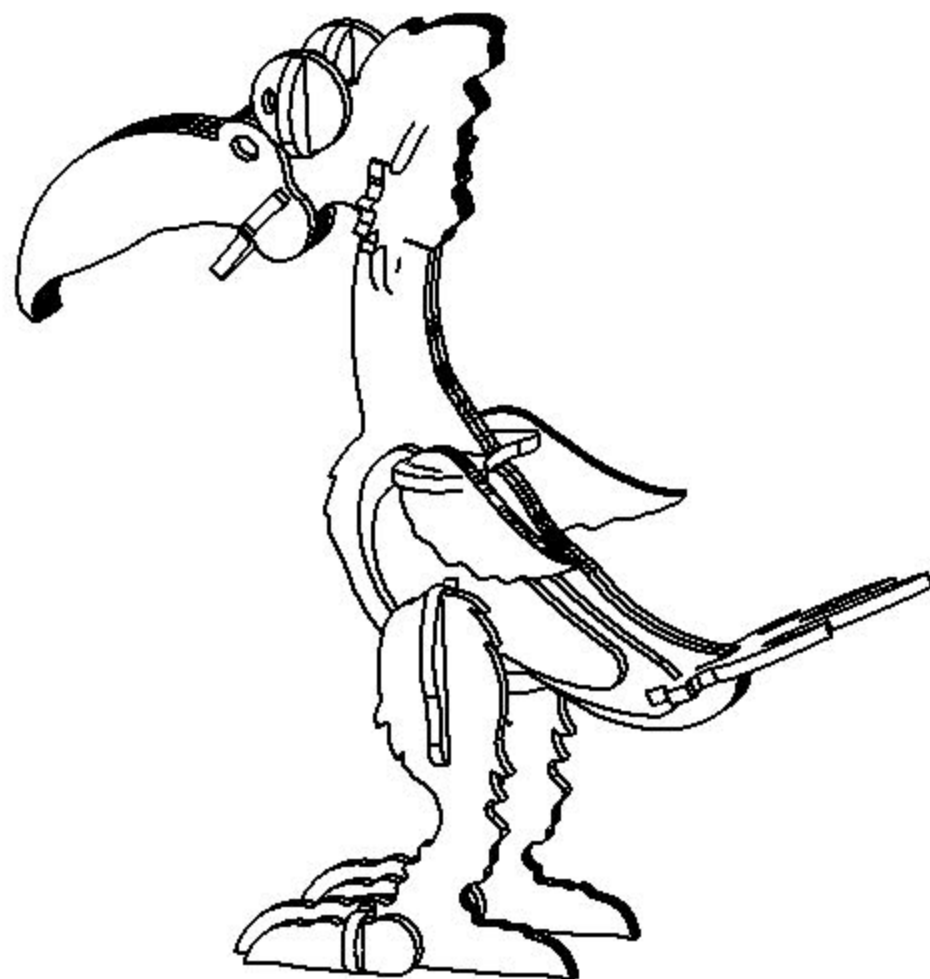
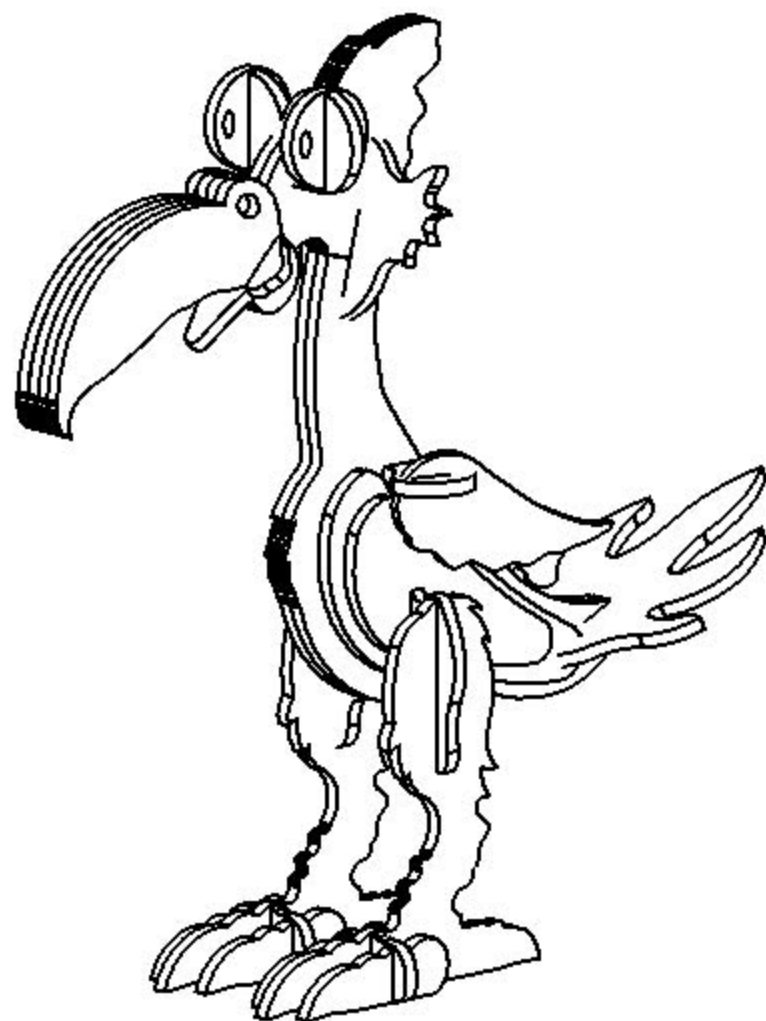
